Frank and I are very excited about this unique opportunity to stay the weekend at the Mount St. Helens Science and Learning Center to learn about the eruption of 1980, plus fish our favorite lake!

Like, CSF, the Mount St. Helens Institute is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization. Our ability to rent the facilities not only helps our club enjoy the beauty and history of the area, but also helps fund the institution. 50% of the rental fees go to the institute; 50% to the grounds upkeep.

There are two co-ed bunkrooms inside the facilities that will accommodate 26 people. Room #1 has 8 bunkbeds (sleeps 16). Room #2, 10 single beds (sleeps 10). Cots are also available if we need extra beds. Bring your own sleeping bags, blankets, pillows, PJ's and personal items (ear plugs). There are on-site restrooms with hot water, but no showers.

Outside the building there is plenty of parking for RV's, trailers and boats. There is also a tent camping area with 17 tent sites if you choose. No open flames are allowed. If you use a stove, it has to be on the pavement (25' away from building and vegetation)

**Unfortunately, dogs are not allowed on the monument.**

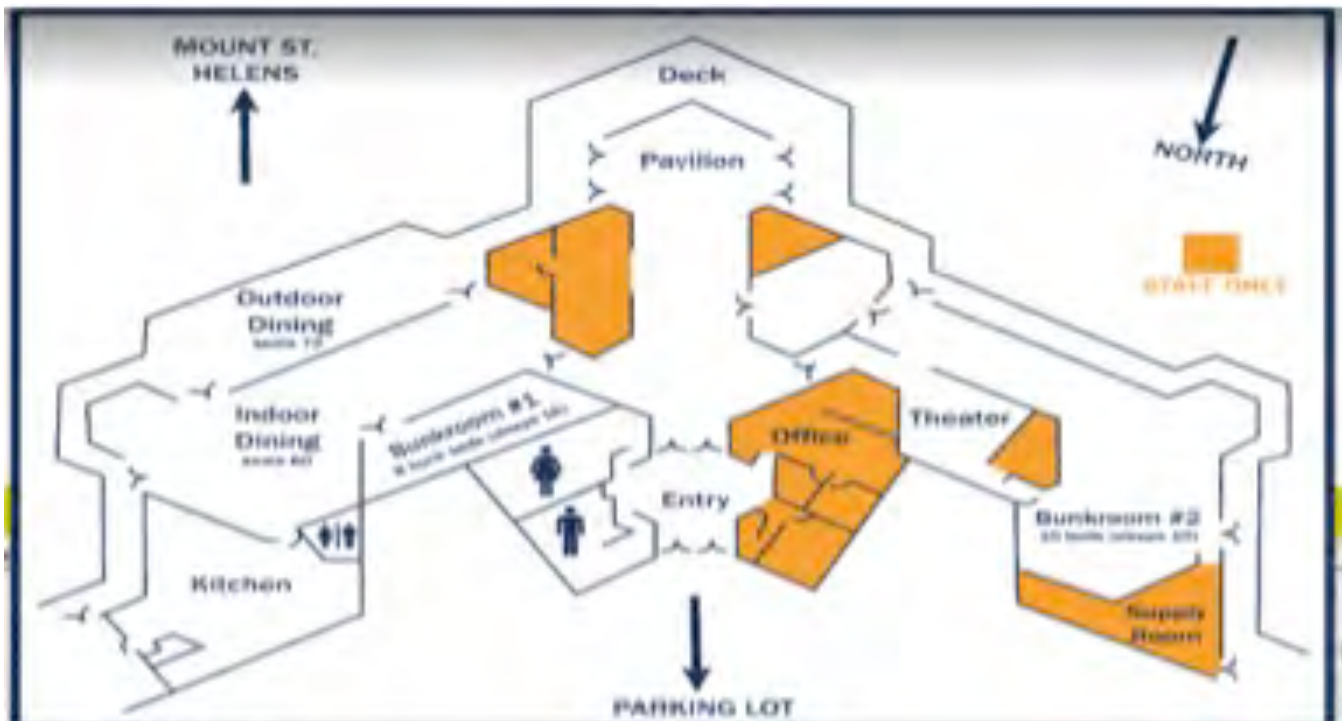
