From 1st St., which becomes Lake Road at SE 192nd, head east for 4 mi. At the light at Lacamas Lake turn right onto NE Everett St. and go a short distance to the park entrance on the right across from Camas Produce.

To get to Fallen Leaf Lake Park take exit 12 from Hwy. 14 continue on 6th Ave 1.5 mi. to NE Garfield St. Turn left and continue on Garfield to NE Everett turn right continue .7 mi. to Fallen Leaf Lake Park. The entrance is on the left across from Camas Produce.
